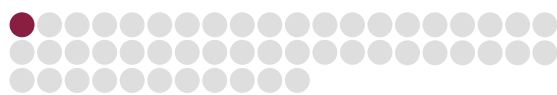

Impact of the daily spending of NFC students attracted to or retained in the region

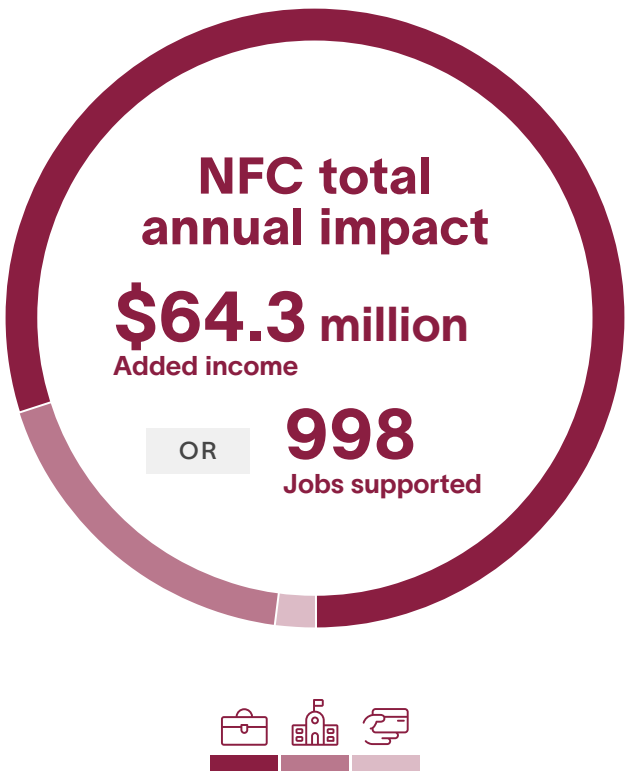
Enough to buy **19** families\* a year's worth of groceries

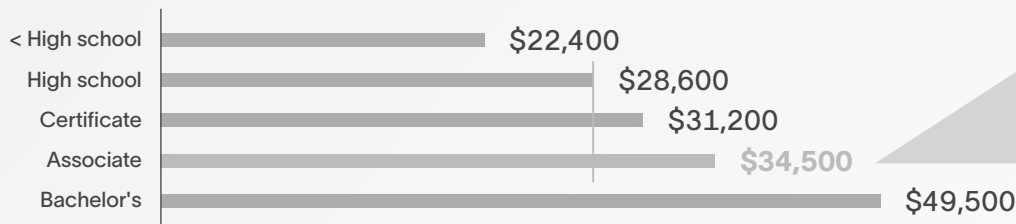

## Investment analysis



### Average earnings by education level at career midpoint



The average associate degree graduate from NFC will see an increase in earnings of **\$5,900** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Florida.

For every \$1...

**Society** gains **\$7.30** in added income and social savings
